## Acts 2:22-32

1. What does Peter tell us about the miracles of Jesus in verse 22?
2. What are the two sides of the story of the events of Good Friday (verse 23)?
3. In verses 25-28, Peter quotes a Psalm of David (Psalm 16), but how do we know that this Psalm cannot be about David, but is about Jesus (see verses 29-31)?
4. Verse 30 tells us that David was prophesying in Psalm 16. How do the prophecies of Jesus death and resurrection strengthen your faith?
5. Twice Peter says that God raised Jesus (verses 24 - from the dead; and verse 32 - to life). Why is this an important detail?
6. How does the fact of eye-witness evidence (end of verse 22 and verse 32) help you to believe?
7. How does the life, death (on a cross) and resurrection of Jesus help you in this time of crisis?
